


**EITR<sup>2</sup>**

**FORKBEARD-ENABLED DDC**



## CONNECTIONS

**1 Connect via USB** to your computer, tablet, phone or streamer.

**2 Plug in the Forkbeard™ module** if you want to use EQ, digital volume, and other Forkbeard capabilities.

**3 Connect the AES output** to any DAC that accepts AES input with an XLR cable.

**4 Connect the coax output** to any DAC that accepts coax input with an RCA cable.

**5 Connect the optical output** to any DAC that accepts optical input with an optical cable.

**6 Turn it on or off** using the power switch.

**7 (Optional) Connect our 6VAC wall-wart** for Linear Override, which gives you 0mA power draw from USB.

**8 Insert a toothpick here** to reset Forkbeard settings. Hold the switch down for 6 seconds while turning the power on.\*

\*Useful if you sell your product. If you don't reset Forkbeard and the new owner doesn't use Forkbeard, they're stuck with your volume and EQ settings. They might not be happy with that.

**1 The front LED indicates when Eitr is on.** That's all it does. It doesn't even change color. Not super exciting, right?

So let's go through some helpful tips.

**All SPDIF outputs are on simultaneously.** AES, coax, and optical are all on when Eitr 2 is on. You can connect 3 separate DACs, one via each output, if you want to.

**Eitr 2 runs fine off just USB.** Don't want to use the wall-wart? You don't have to. As long as your USB output can provide 500mA of current, you're good.

**Eitr 2 is a driverless device.** It's UAC2 compliant, the universal standard for audio via USB. You shouldn't have trouble plugging and playing with pretty much anything.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

**"Draws too much power" error?** You'll need to use the wall-wart. Turn Eitr 2 off, plug in the wall-wart, and turn it back on.

**No sound?** You may need to select Eitr 2 in both Control Panel (Windows) or System Prefs (Mac) AND in your player software or streaming service interface.

## SAFETY



1. If you don't know how to install audio devices, get a qualified professional to help.
2. Never use this device near water, do not expose to rain or moisture, and clean only with a dry cloth.
3. Assure adequate ventilation, do not block ventilation openings, or place near heat sources.
4. Use only the supplied wall-wart or suitable replacement. Route cords away from traffic areas and protect them from being pinched. Unplug the wall-wart from the outlet if the apparatus is unused for a long period of time.
5. To prevent electric shock, do not use the plug with an extension cord, receptacle, or outlet unless blades can be fully inserted.
6. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Service is required when the device has been damaged, including cord or plug damage, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the device, the device has been exposed to rain or moisture, does not operate normally, or has been dropped.

Schiit Audio warrants to the original purchaser that this product shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for three (3) years from the date of purchase. If a defect covered by this warranty occurs during this period, Schiit Audio will repair the defective product, free of charge. Date of purchase will be based on customer receipts, otherwise date of manufacturing will be used.

**If you believe you need warranty service, contact us first.** Schiit Audio products sent back to us without a Return Authorization (RA) will be returned to the sender without repair. To contact us and obtain an RA, email [info@schiiit.com](mailto:info@schiiit.com).
